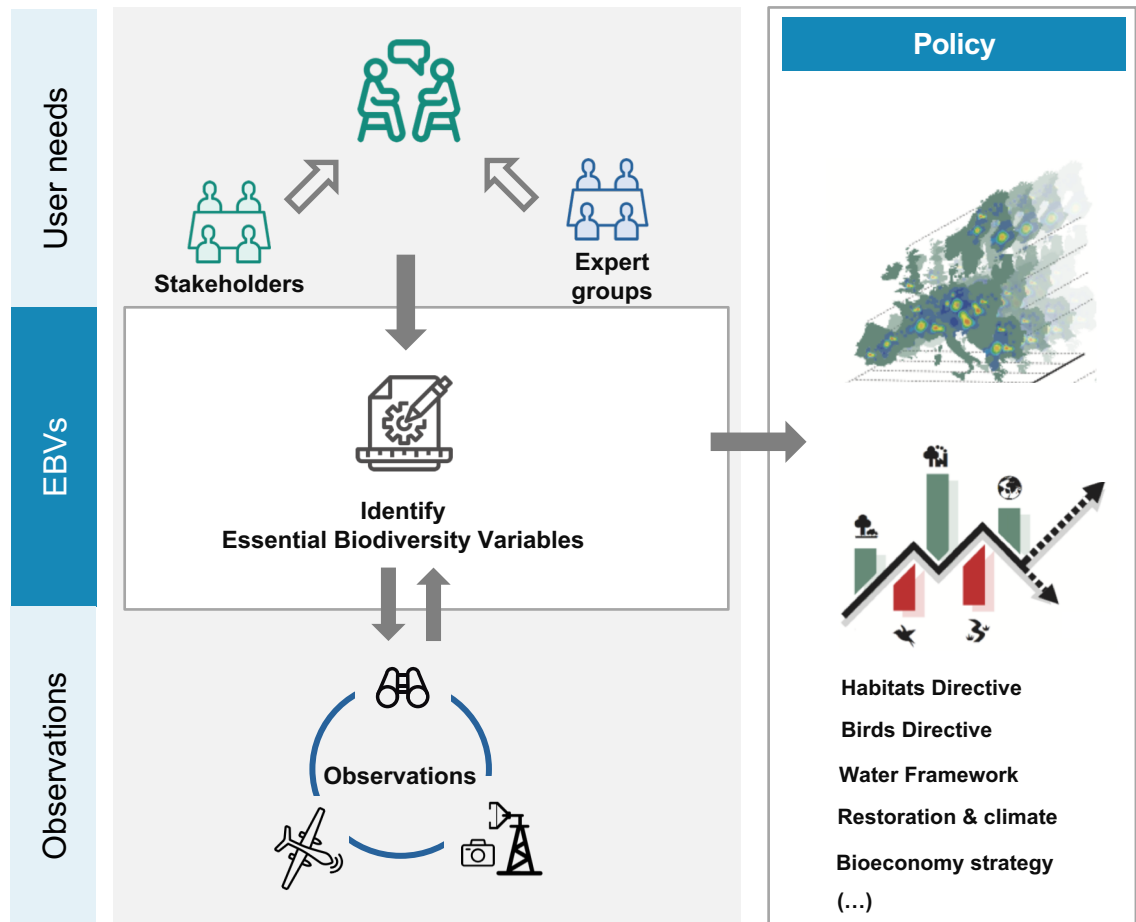

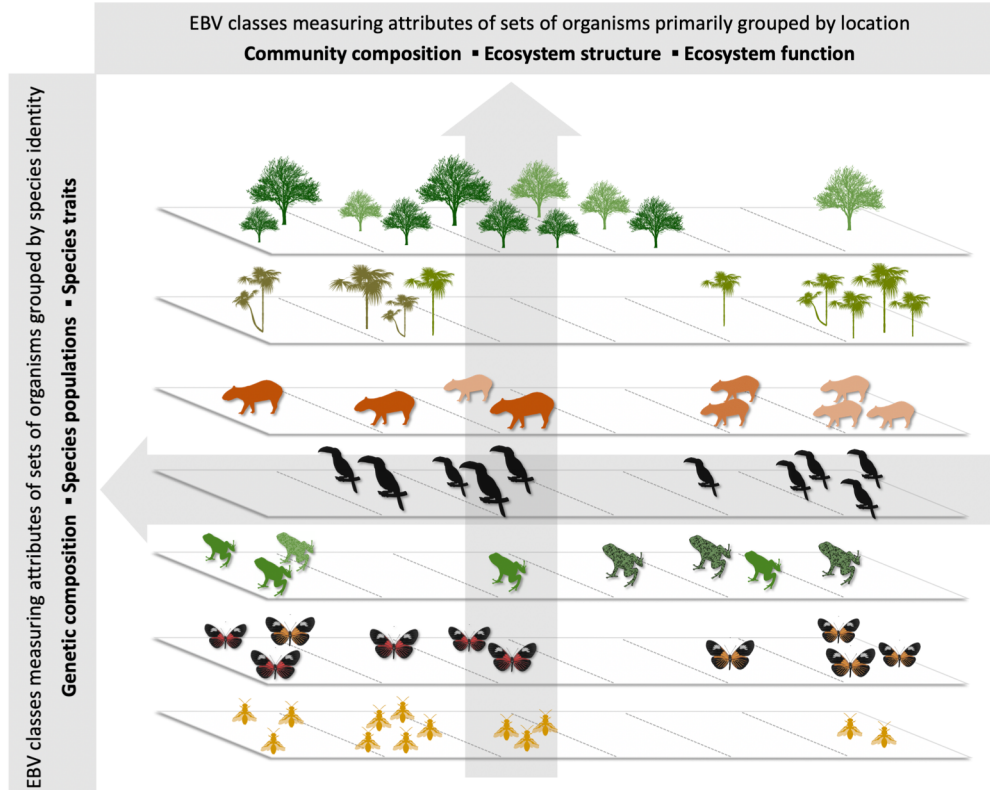

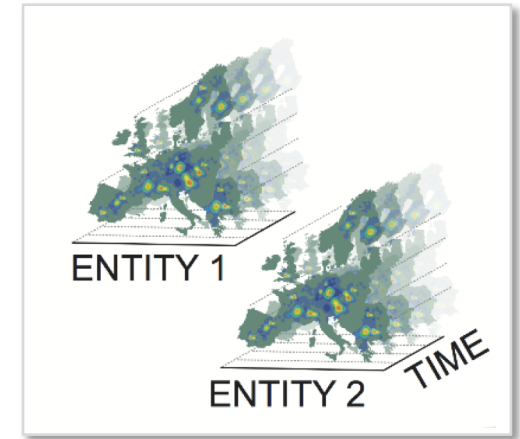

Needs:

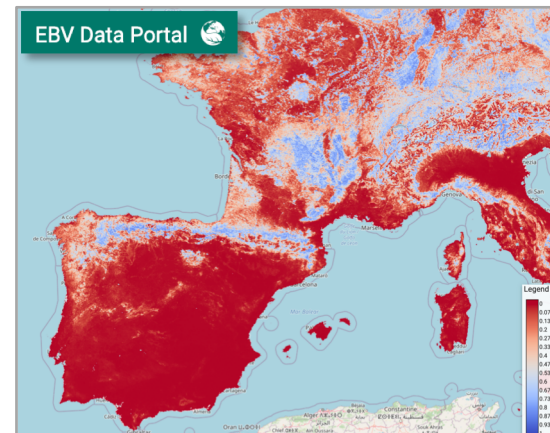
Spatially consistent information
